ACCTI CRITERIA REQUIREMENTS FOR VOTING MEMBERS

The follo	owing c	checklist must be completed and duly signed indicating corporation's adherence to membership criteria.
YES	NO	The corporation performs services in accordance to the ACCTI Code of Professional Conduct, Ethics and Business Practices.
		The corporation's core business is in traditional translation and/or interpretation services along with additional support services as applicable to the open market at a profit (excluding grants or subsidies).
		The corporation deals directly with the professional translators and/or interpreters who perform the work on the majority of its projects.
		The corporation is a privately owned or publicly held business incorporated in Canada and has its registered office located in Canada. It is not a crown corporation or government agency unless it qualifies under Article VII.
		The corporation has been incorporated for a minimum of five (5) years prior to the date of this application. Should that not apply, the corporation has been in the business for seven (7) years or more operating under up to two (2) different company names, with the same ownership, management and/or majority ownership.
		The corporation has been actively promoting its translation and/or interpretation services for a minimum of (5) years through mediums such as Yellow Pages or specialized directories. Such promotion used the same name by which it is currently identified to the public (whether corporation or trade name) and list as its address an Established Office for at least five (5) years.
		The corporation may be part of a larger entity much like a department provided all other criteria is met. However, it is led by an independent director or executive officer, and has a separate budget. Such applicant may not include, in consideration of its ability to qualify, revenues generated from dealings with parent or affiliated companies as defined in Income Tax Act or government branches. The corporation has offered and provided services to non-affiliated firms for at least five (5) years at a profit.
		The corporation has had a minimum annual gross revenue derived from traditional translation and/or interpretation services of two hundred and fifty thousand (\$250,000.00) dollars for each of the past two (2) fiscal years prior to their application for membership. Revenues from other sources such as desktop publishing and machine translation are not to be considered.
		The corporation relies on translators and/or interpreters other than the principals (those who have a direct or indirect ownership interest) of the company for more than 80% of its annual core business revenue.
